Cash Cup Rules

There will be a short team captain meeting before each round. This rules page will cover everything you need to know Team captains will need to check in when they arrive and pick up the rules sheet and rosters.

All teams and players should be ready to play at their scheduled match time. We will start with matches 1 to 8 and follow the match schedule from there. Teams should arrive 30 minutes before their first match. Directly after your first match is completed, teams will be expected to be available to play. Your match could be called ahead of schedule. If your team is not present, THE MATCH WILL BE FORFEITED. We will not wait for teams or players to show up. YOU HAVE BEEN PRE-WARNED!

This is a Single elimination Toledo style tournament and each match will be a race to 8.

Teams that qualify all 3 sessions are the first to get byes. If there are other byes to be filled on the bracket they will randomly drawn.

All matches will be on split tables. Matches may be played on 3 tables if necessary. All Semi Final and Final Matches will be played on 3 tables. Number of tables used is solely up to the Tournament Director.

Toledo style means that each team will list their five players in order from their lowest to their highest on the score sheet and the match will start with the two lowest players playing one game. Then the two second lowest will play one game and so on. Teams that have two or more players of the same skill level may place those players in any order.

Teams will fill out their roster and then hand that roster to the opponent. This must be done when the matches are called. You may not wait for a player to show up to decide who to play. A coin is flipped to determine which team fills out the player roster first. Cannot exceed 23 and only 2 Senior Skill levels can play in a match.

Players will lag to start each individual game. The first time through the order teams will play 8-Ball. The second time through the order the teams will play 9-Ball. The final time through the order the teams will alternate 8-Ball and 9-Ball

If a player is playing on another table teams may skip over that match and come back to it when that player is available. It is not a forfeit. There are 3 rounds of play in each match. No player is to play a 4th match. All players will play 3 times or unless the match ends before then

<u>There is no coaching</u>. Players must stand away from their team. As always, telling a player to mark their pocket or what category of balls they are on is not considered coaching.

Teams and players trying to cheat and coach their players will be dealt with and may be removed from the tournament. This is a no coaching tournament and coaching will not be tolerated.

Teams are to sit only at the tables designated for their matches. Please leave the table immediately following your match but also leave a clean table that the next teams do not have to clean up your mess.

Common player situations will be decided by the Tournament Director at the time they occur. A team match involving common players, the common player must either declare for a team or sit out.
