

## True or False

Accidentally moved object balls can be replaced by either player at anytime during the course of the shot so as to avoid a foul with the cue ball.

## False

Accidentally moved balls must be replaced, unless any of the accidentally moved balls make contact with the cue ball, thereby creating a ball-in-hand foul, in which case nothing gets replaced. If the accidental movements between shots the ball must be replaced **by the opponent** before the shot is taken. Any balls moved accidentally during a shot must be replaced **by the opponent** after the shot is over and all balls have stopped rolling.

NOTE: An object ball that is in motion and makes accidental contact with a bridge, cue stick, etc., is not replaced!

If, during the course of the shot, another ball stops in the position previously occupied by the accidentally moved ball, **the opponent must place the accidentally moved ball, in a fair manner, as close as possible to it's original position.**
