

FAQ'S regarding Safer at Play Policy

My team cannot start at 6pm. It's hard enough to get there at 6:30. **If it IS possible for any player(s) to start early, that is fine. If not, that is fine. That is why this section is written as a REQUEST.**

Regarding the Coach and "being there" the way it is written is kind of a tip off that it is obvious teams would want to play the Coach always in the 3rd match to keep them there for both parts of the whole team match. **Yes, I meant to do that. There IS another option for SOME Host Locations, there could be enough space ELSEWHERE in the Host Location for the Coach to be or even outside (and could be called in for Time-Outs).**

For Double Jeopardy, would we be allowed to have 4-5 players there? Two to play and two to keep score and one coach? **Do not think about this as ONE Double Jeopardy Team. Think about this as TWO teams, an 8 Ball and a 9 Ball Team because you are playing and sitting on two separate tables.**

For those that do not own their own cue sticks, will they be allowed to use house cues? And will these be cleaned by host locations? **Yes, it is MY understanding that HOST LOCATIONS are or have removed common cues and they are "checked out" by customers and then "checked in" for cleaning. This is NOT under the control of the APA but is under the Host Location's responsibility.**

What if the person you DECLARED for the 1st match gets sick, gets stuck at work, etc. What Happens then? **Treat others the way you would want to be treated. If Player 1 gets sick and there is ADVANCE notice, call the opposing Team Captain AT ONCE so they can also make a change, if the 1st player is stuck at work then the opposing Team also gets to change their starting player.**

Does the Team Captain HAVE to be the player INCLUDED in the 1st 4 Players? **No. I "Assumed" that the Team Captain would WANT to be the player who was involved from beginning to end of match. So, I am re-revising this to read: Co-Captain, Coach, ScoreKeeper, Spare Player. You know what happens when you "assume". Good Catch Tim Fugatt Sr.!**

THIS NEEDS ITS OWN SECTION – NOT EVERY HOST LOCATION AND/OR DIVISION IS CREATED EQUALLY. YOU, THE TEAM CAPTAIN, THE PLAYER NEED TO LOOK AT YOUR HOST LOCATION AND DIVISION TO SEE IF ANYONE IS ACTUALLY GOING TO NEED TO "STAGGER IN". WHEREAS ONLY 4 PLAYERS FROM THE TEAM WILL BE ALLOWED TO SIT AT THE TEAM'S SITTING TABLE, THERE MIGHT BE MORE THAN ENOUGH ROOM THROUGHTOUT THE BAR (YOUR HOST LOCATION) FOR THE REST OF THE TEAM TO ENJOY THE NIGHT. YOU ALSO NEED TO BE AWARE OF YOUR HOST LOCATION'S 50% CAPACITY AND/OR THEIR LICENSE (BECAUSE THAT IS IN PLAY TOO WITH THE GOVERNOR'S MANDATE). WE CANNOT RUN THROUGH ALL YOUR SCENARIOS FOR YOU. WE HAVE ONLY OUTLINED, THE VERY MOST CROWDED SCENARIO, WHICH SOME OF OUR HOST LOCATIONS DO FALL UNDER.
